

Inline Stick n'Puck Rules and Regulations

- Class registration is online only. Go to the link below to set up an account:

- All ages and skill levels, for practice only. No scrimmages are permitted.
- Registration will be closed at the start time for each session. Please register ahead of time.
- Full Gear is required to play. Player list is below:
 - · Helmets with full face cage or shield,
 - shin pads
- chest protector
- shoulder pads
- elbow pads
- gloves
- pants
- inline skates (four wheels.
- · Goalies must add leg pads, catcher and blocker

- A professional skating coach can be hired for a private (one skater and one coach) or a semi-private (two skaters and one coach) lesson.
- A coach must follow all rink guidelines for submitting proper credentials, which include insurance and membership in the Roller Hockey Association (RHA).
- Coaching, teaching or instructing is not permitted except as authorized by rink management, whether or not the coach, teacher or instructor receives remuneration.
- Be aware of the players around you.
- No more than 2 skaters are permitted in a semi-private lesson.
- No organized games.
- Allow goalies time to recover from saves before shooting.
- Do not shoot while another player is in front of or behind the net.
- Pick up the pucks, replace them in the puck bucket and leave the rink as soon as the session is over.
- Please be aware of your surroundings, avoid shooting at the goal.
- Please be sure of your purchase. We do not offer credits, transfers or refunds for any reason. No exceptions.
