## RINK RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR ROLLER SKATING

- By purchasing this admission ticket, you are aware that roller skating involves certain inherent risks, which may cause serious injury. You freely volunteer to participate and accept all known and unknown while in the roller skating facility. Further, you release the roller skating rink, its sponsors, its operators and its equipment suppliers against any claims and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense you may incur. This wristband is valid for this session only. NO REFUNDS, NO CREDITS. NON-TRANSFERABLE. NO REPLACEMENTS.
- Skaters must purchase public session wristbands and must affix them to wrists for visible inspection at any time.
- No running, horseplay, or unruly behavior on or off the roller rink.
- No stick or puck horseplay allowed on or off the roller rink.
- No food or beverages allowed on the roller rink.
- No smoking anywhere or at any time in Prospect Park.
- While on the roller rink, no talking on cellphones, or holding cellphones, and no use of any portable electronic devices, i.e., cameras, iPods, headphones, ear buds, etc.
- Skating in a manner that, in the opinion of management or staff, endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety or pleasure, is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule may result in ejection from the facility.
- Pass or overtake carefully. Roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through other skaters is prohibited. Violation of this rule may result in ejection from the facility.
- No tag or games of any kind are permitted on or off the roller rink.
- No more than two people may skate together.
- Groups cannot gather anywhere on the roller rink.
- No shoes permitted on the roller rink.
- Please use caution when entering or exiting the roller rink.
- Player boxes are not available for customers' use at any time.
- While on the roller rink, skaters must move in directions indicated by rink guards or by general announcement.
- While on the roller rink, skaters are not permitted to carry children. Everyone must be skating.
- While on the roller rink, skaters are not permitted to carry or bring with them such items as handbags, cross-body bags, cameras, backpacks, cell phones or any other hand-held object.
- Skaters and spectators must not sit on, lean over or leave articles on the dasher boards.
- Exits must be kept clear at all times.
- Malicious incidents or destruction of property must be reported to rink guards or rink management immediately.
- Sitting or lying on the roller rink for any length of time is not permitted.
- All skaters aged 13 and under must be supervised at all times by a parent or guardian (guardian must be 18 years of age or older).
- Skaters must be aged 14 or older to purchase admission and rental skates.
- Backward skating, jumps, spins, leg extension, hockey stops, hydroplanes are prohibited on public sessions.
- Socks must be worn at all times when using rental skates.
- Lace skates tightly and securely (all the way to the top.)
- Coaching, teaching or instructing is not permitted except as authorized by rink management, whether or not the coach, teacher or instructor receives remuneration.
- No video or photography or any image capture is permitted, on or off the rink.
- Management is not responsible for personal items missing, lost, stolen or left within or near rink or facility.
- Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the roller rink or the facility at any time, for any reason.

### PLEASE NOTE

- SKATING CONDITIONS MAY NOT ALWAYS BE PERFECT.
- BEWARE OF ALL HAZARDS.
- CEMENT SURFACE MAY BE SLIPPERY DURING HUMID WEATHER.
- ALWAYS SKATE ACCORDING TO PREVAILING CONDITIONS AND RINK GUARDS ADVICE.

### RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF ALL CLAIMS BY PERSONS ENTERING THIS FACILITY

The participant and/or their parent(s) or guardian(s) understand, acknowledge and agree that roller skating is an inherently dangerous and physically demanding activity. Participating skater assumes full responsibility for any risk of injury, property damage, or death while participating in activities at this establishment.

Participant and/or their parent(s) or guardian(s) hereby waive any and all claims including, but not limited to, bodily injury including death and property damage they may have against LeFrak Center at Lakeside, and all sponsors of the roller rink establishment and their subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, officers, directors, employees, agents, and volunteers arising out of Participant's use of the roller rink and all surrounding areas.

Participants and/or their parent(s) or guardians hereby release and hold harmless LeFrak Center at Lakeside and all sponsors of the ice rink establishment and their subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, officers, directors, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability for any loss, damage, or expense that the Participants or their respective heirs, assigns and legal representatives may suffer as a result of Participant's use of the roller rink, from any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to, negligence or breach of contract

on the part of LeFrak Center at Lakeside, and all sponsors of the roller rink establishment, in the operation, supervision, design, maintenance, or condition of the ice surface, or of the roller rink and all surrounding areas. Participant agrees to abide by the "Rink Rules and Guidelines", as posted within the roller rink area, for the use of the skating rink and will follow the instructions of the operating staff of the rink. Failure to follow these codes of conduct may result in the termination of Participant's use of the roller rink, the rental ice skates, and the surrounding areas without refund.

Participant permits LeFrak Center at Lakeside to use any photographs, videotapes, recordings or any other records taken while on the roller rink premises for publicity, advertising, or any other legitimate purpose.
