Youth and Adult Hockey Classes Terms and Conditions

- Class registration is online only. Go to the link below to set up an account:

- Tuition must be paid in advance. No payment plans, credits or refunds.
- Same day walk-in or call-in registration is not permitted.
- LeFrak Center at Lakeside reserves the right to change or cancel the day or time of any given class. Maximum 10-12 students per class. Levels may be combined if fewer than three skaters are registered for a given class.
- Name tags will be given to, and must be worn by, all registered class participants during each class. A \$5 fee will be charged for all lost or forgotten name tags.
- A name tag is not transferable. Any breach of this term will entitle World Ice Arena to demand surrender and cancellation of the remaining classes, with no refund issued.
- Using your name tag and on the day of your class, skaters may practice on a public session for free during the semester in which they're enrolled.
- Missed classes, activities, reservations or sessions of any kind (including due to COVID-19 and/or quarantining) cannot be transferred to another session, rescheduled, credited or refunded for any reason unless cancelled by LeFrak at Lakeside. Your registration guarantees you a space in the class regardless of your attendance. No exceptions.
- We reserve the right to change or cancel the time or day of a class or clinic. If fewer than four skaters enroll in a class or clinic, that class or clinic may be cancelled or combined with another class or clinic.
- Participation in these programs is at your child's own risk. LeFrak Center at Lakeside and their officers, directors, instructors and personnel are released from all liability when a child under the age of 18 is present in the rink.
- Full gear required for all classes.
- Please be sure of your purchase. We do not offer credits, transfers or refunds for any reason. No exceptions.

Participants and/or their parent(s) or guardians hereby release and hold harmless LeFrak Center at Lakeside and all sponsors of the roller rink establishment and their subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, officers, directors, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability for any loss, damage, or expense that the Participants or their respective heirs, assigns and legal representatives may suffer as a result of Participant's use of the roller rink, from any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to,

negligence or breach of contract on the part of LeFrak Center at Lakeside, and all sponsors of the roller rink establishment, in the operation, supervision, design, maintenance, or condition of the ice surface, or of the roller rink and all surrounding areas

Failure to follow these codes of conduct may result in the termination of Participant's use of the roller rink, the rental skates, and the surrounding areas without refund.

By purchasing an admission ticket and/or entering the roller rink area, you are aware that roller inline skating involves certain inherent risks which may cause serious injury or death.
